The participants played six extremely thrilling preelimination rounds while supported by a couple of cheer squads from all over the world (especially from Australia, Japan, Spain and Poland). With six victories Matej Tabak from the Slovak Republic was unbeaten and swept right into the semi finals. Two more players with five victories made it also: Takafumi Mochiduki from Japan and Ricardo Gomes from Portugal. The amazing number of 8 players reached the fourth place so we had to use the Buchholz method to resolve this tie. With the best Buchholz former World Champion Pantelis Litsardopoulos from Greece got the last available place in the semi finals and made it even into the final game where he lost against Takafumi Mochiduki.
